Missionary Spotlight

Tim & Lois Hunter, Spoken Worldwide

The Hunters spent over 35 years serving in various roles with Wycliffe Bible Translators and now use that same expertise with Spoken Worldwide. Tim grew up in Cameroon, West Africa, the son of missionaries who translated the New Testament for the Kapsiki people. Lois grew up in the USA, praying for missionaries. Both felt an early desire in life to be part of what God is doing to expand his kingdom around the world.

They spent more than 10 years overseas in Cameroon, Chad, and Nigeria. Tim currently mentors indigenous translation teams in African oral preference communities as they use oral Bible translation methods to give God's Word to their communities.

Update: Tim and Lois are currently in Bali, Indonesia for a few days of vacation and to celebrate 45 years of marriage. In the meantime, preparations are being made for the new OBT project in Cameroon which should begin in August. Please pray as those involved in this ministry.
