Jonathan & Beka, Middle East

Jonathan and Beka, along with their five children, spent 13 years serving the Lord in the Atlanta area, proclaiming the good news of Christ to refugees living there. Working with Mission to the World, they had a mercy ministry among immigrants from the Middle East and was focused on the Muslim political refugees sent to Atlanta. Their new assignment has taken them back to the mission field in the Middle East.
